RE: Spring 2006 Enrollment

The total enrollment at the third-week census date for the spring 2006 quarter was 13,969, which is 51 fewer than the number of students enrolled in the spring of 2005. This includes 13,738 continuing, 20 new, 195 returning, and 6 visiting students.

The fall-winter-spring three-quarter average headcount for the 2005-06 academic year is 14,522 (14,482 Budgeted FTE). This is the first year of a two year phased State buyout of all summer enrollments. This year included in our budgeted enrollments are 61 FTE Summer Education Masters students (funded in prior years), plus 349 FTE of general summer enrollment FTE. The addition of 410 total State supported summer FTE brings the total campus FTE for the 2005-06 academic year to 14,892.
