RE: Fall 2002 Enrollment

The enrollment at the third-week census date for the fall quarter is 14,122, an increase of 975 students (7.4%) over last fall. Fall enrollments include 8,453 continuing, 208 returning, 4,162 new students, and 5 visitors. The fall-winter-spring three-quarter average headcount for the 2002-03 academic year is projected at 13,640 (13,611 student FTE). Including the students enrolled in the summer 2002 State funded Education Masters Program – the total student FTE for the 2002-03 academic year is projected at 13,700.
