Charge: The Campus Welfare Committee (CWC) provides an administrative forum for discussions of key issues of concern to students, faculty, and or staff, in order to provide the necessary background for informed deliberation. Areas of focus include:

- Understanding and advising on the impact that planning decisions have on the welfare of students, faculty, and staff;
- Identifying issues, risks, and opportunities associated with campus planning that should be factored into the decision-making process;
- Raising issues of student, faculty, or staff welfare that are of importance to the campus community, and assist with increased education and communication about these issues; and
- Developing mitigations or alternatives, and/or recommending courses of actions, regarding campus welfare issues.

The CWC is expected to solicit and incorporate the views of relevant Senate committees and administrative advisory committees.
