Charge

The Advisory Committee for Facilities (ACF) provides an administrative forum for developing and budgeting for the campus' capital plan; for reviewing area master planning studies, building sites and designs; and for reviewing issues of space utilization and allocation/re-allocation in order to provide the necessary background material for informed deliberation within the PAC. Areas of focus include:

- Recommend major and minor capital improvements program priorities.
- Responsible for Campus Space Plan; recommend Space Plan changes and space allocations for I&R, general administration, student services, and student life functions.
- Advise on matters concerning physical planning of facilities on university-owned lands operated by the campus (e.g., area master plans, siting and building design).
- Recommend priorities for and evaluate the impact of proposed actions affecting capital improvements and space (both on- and off-campus). For example,
 - Property leases
 - Campus debt capacity
- Provide a forum for the negotiations of space issues to the extent needed.
- Identify issues, risks, and opportunities associated with campus planning initiatives.

The ACF is expected to solicit and incorporate into the materials prepared for PAC the views of relevant Senate committees and administrative advisory committees.
