Charge

The Campus Welfare Committee (CWC) provides an administrative forum for bringing together discussions of key issues of concern to students, faculty, or staff in order to provide the necessary background material for informed deliberation within the PAC. Areas of focus include:

- Understand and advise on the impact of planning decisions and priorities on the welfare of students, faculty, and staff.
- Identify issues, risks, and opportunities associated with campus planning initiatives that should be factored into the decision-making process.
- Raise student, faculty, or staff welfare of importance to the campus community and assist with increase understanding through education and communication.
- Based upon articulated campus values, directions, objectives and priorities, develop mitigations, alternatives, and/or recommend courses of action concerning such campus welfare issues.

The CWC is expected to solicit and incorporate into the materials prepared for PAC the views of relevant Senate committees and administrative advisory committees.
