**DESCRIPTION**

The Academic Senate of the University of California is empowered by the Board of Regents to exercise direct control over academic matters of central importance to the University. Its chief responsibility is to authorize, approve, and supervise all courses and to determine the conditions for admissions, certificates, and degrees. Every regular faculty member at the University is a member of the Academic Senate. Collectively, the nine Senate divisions form the universitywide Academic Senate, which represents the entire faculty through the Assembly of the Academic Senate. The Assembly meets to take legislative action on matters that affect more than one campus. The universitywide Senate functions through its committees, which correspond to committees with similar responsibilities at the campus level. A key universitywide committee, the Academic Council, acts as the executive arm of the Assembly.
